



BC VOCATIONAL, TRADE AND TECHNICAL SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

This scholarship was established by BC Council to recognize the career pursuits of girl members who choose a vocational, trade and/or technical pathway. It allows them fund to be able to continue their education and offers financial assistance towards a field that will enhance the life of the recipients.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this bursary, the applicant must:

- Be an active member in good standing of Girl Guides of Canada.
- Have been active in BC Guiding for the last three years.
- Be a resident of BC.
- Be a registered grade 12 student at a BC secondary school (independent, home and private schools included).
- Be planning to attend a vocational, trade and/or technical institution (all fields of study are eligible) to complete a certificate or diploma program.
- Show a commitment to service in her school and community.

REQUIREMENTS

1. The bursary is conditional upon acceptance at a vocational, trade and technical institution of the recipient's choice.
2. The bursary must be used within 18 months of the date of notification.
3. The recipient(s) is encouraged to continue her involvement in Guiding.
4. Successful applicants are eligible to receive one, and only one, of the girl scholarships that the BC Awards Committee decides.
