ORIGIN OF BOOK OF HONOUR

The Book of Honour was created to recognize outstanding BC Guiders and girls who exemplify the spirit of Guiding. The archival quality Book of Honour and Bursary of Honour is on display at the provincial office.

The objective of the Book of Honour award is:

- To create a special, lasting form of recognition of outstanding members throughout the years.
- To help fund the Bursary of Honour; which encourages post-secondary education and training for youth members of Girl Guides of Canada–Guides du Canada in BC.

TRAVELLING BOOKS

A travelling Book of Honour for each area and a travelling Bursary of Honour book are kept at the provincial office. These can be borrowed for display at an area or provincial event, conference or workshop. This allows more members the opportunity to see the book and may encourage future nominations for inclusion in the Book of Honour and applications for the Bursary of Honour.

The person listed as the **Contact Person** on the reservation form is responsible for the safekeeping of the travelling books when on loan. This person is also responsible for returning the book to the provincial office within ten days of the event.

The travelling books must be reserved and can either be picked up at the provincial office or sent by courier to the designated contact person. Expenses incurred are the area's responsibility.
